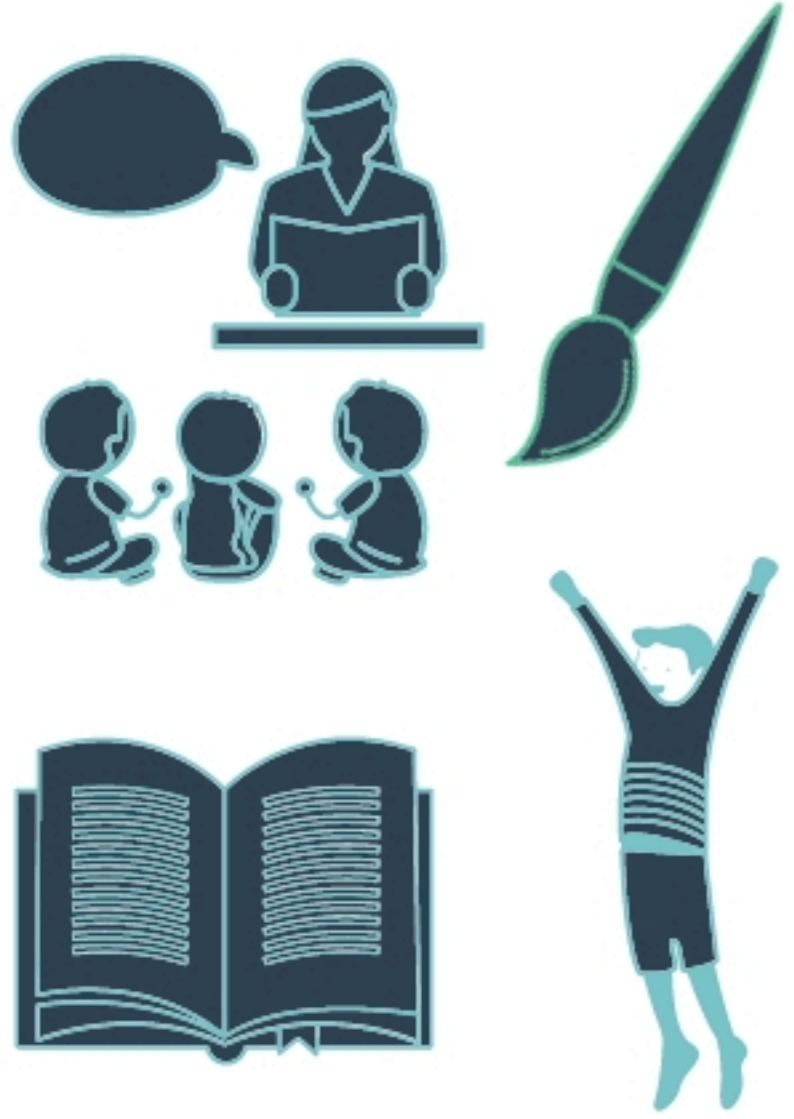

CHURCH CONNECTIONS

- Sanctuary Choir – over 40 weeks of beautiful music provided in our services
- Women Connecting – meets 8x/year and engage in broad topics
- Men's Connection – over 40 weeks of gatherings with meaningful conversation and study

- Women of Westminster - serve the Tiburon Thrift Shop

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Mill Street Shelter meals – monthly
- Wednesday Lunch Program – weekly meals for the food insecure
- Marinship Pop-Up Pantry – weekly delivery of groceries to people in Marinship Park
- Park Street Chaplaincy Dinner – over 8 times/year, provide meals for people experiencing homelessness
- Alternative Christmas Fair
- Marin Food Bank – gather and deliver donations during Lent
- Summer service trip to rebuild Lake County homes
- Habitat for Humanity – provide work groups several times per year
- Voyager Carmel – provide meals at Christmas and Easter
- Tiburon Half Marathon – provide water station

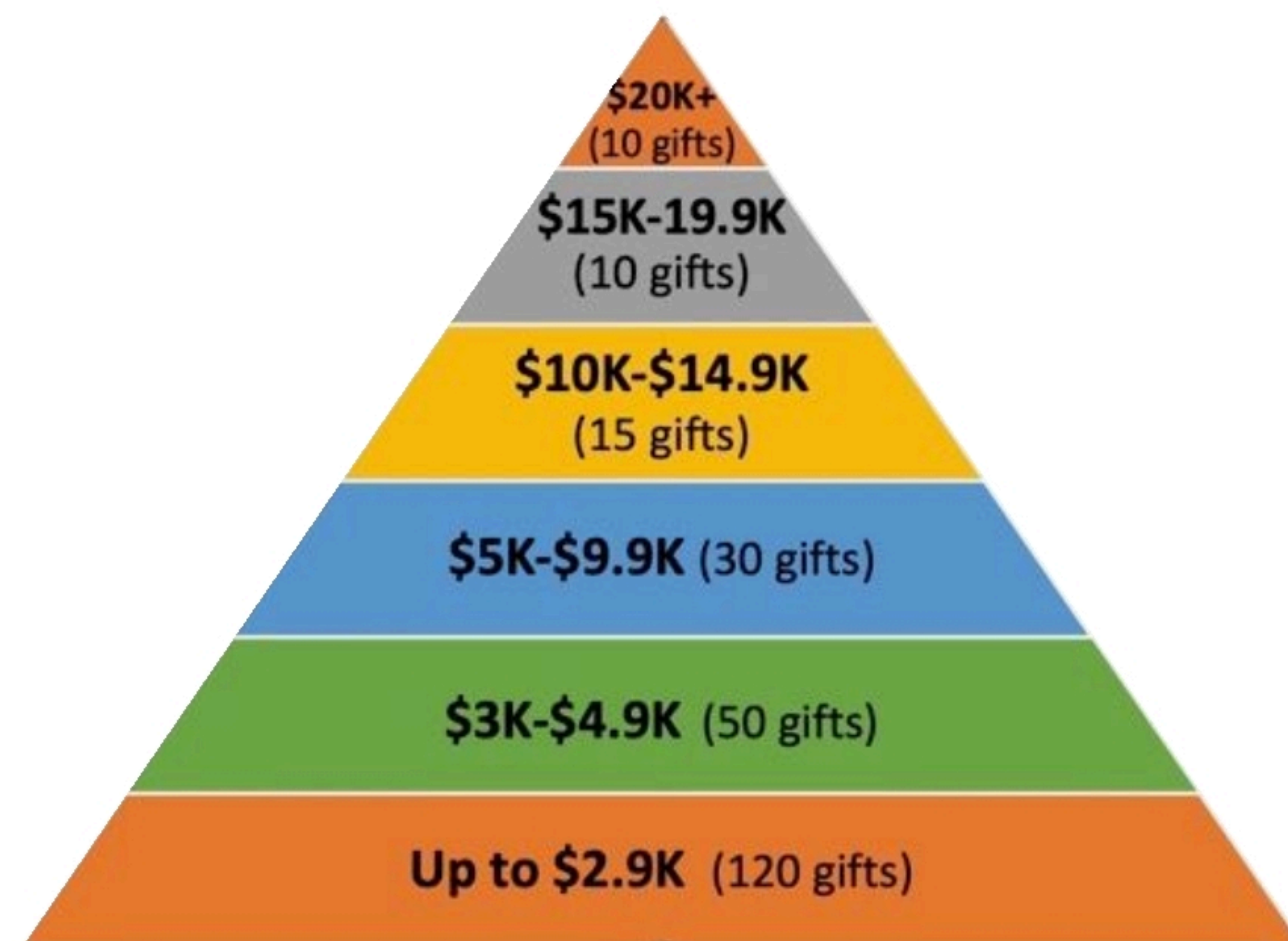
2021 STEWARDSHIP GOAL
