2022 STEWARDSHIP GOAL

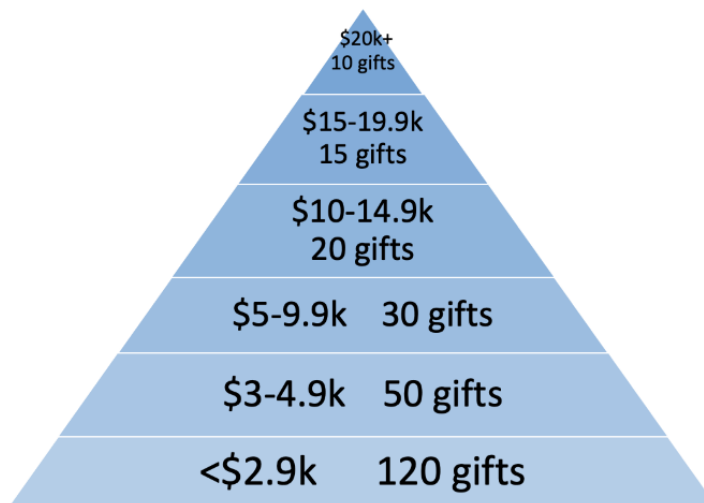
100% participation Pledges of \$775,000
